According to an article by Observer Research Foundation, bike taxis are an alternative to enhancing urban mobility in India. The Central Government allowed motorcycles to be categorized as a transport vehicle under the Motor Vehicles Act in November 20043. However, there have been some regulatory challenges that have held back bike taxi services in India. Ola and Uber are two major players in the bike taxi market in India5. Uber operates its bike-taxi services across 30 cities in the country and claims to facilitate over 150K trips a day.
