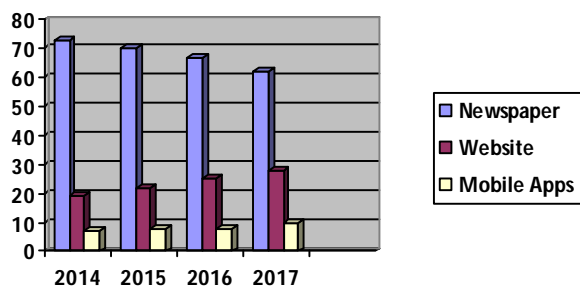


Figure 1. Acceptance of Online E-Newspaper by Customer
